

THE OKAZAKI KAHEITA INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

GUIDE TO APPLICATION FOR THE 2026 YEAR

The Okazaki Kaheita International Scholarship Foundation (The Foundation) was established in March 1990 to contribute to world peace and development by fostering people from the countries in Asia. This foundation strives to promote mutual understanding and international exchange as well as to pay homage to and immortalize the spirit of Okazaki Kaheita, a man who worked for mutual understanding, peace, and world friendship.

In order to promote friendship between Japan and Asian countries and to further the personal development of people in these countries, the foundation provides scholarships to students from Asian countries who wish to study in graduate schools in Japan.

Applicant and Fields of Study

The applicant shall be qualified to pursue a course of study and research, with Japanese as the medium of instruction, in a **master's course** at a Japanese university.

The applicant shall be free to choose his/her own field of study, excluding medicine, dentistry, veterinary science and private MBA.

Number of Scholarships

People's Republic of CHINA : 2

The applicant shall be a graduate and recommended by one of the Appointed Universities in China by the Foundation.

The appointed universities as follows

- ① Fudan University
- ② Shanghai Jiao Tong University
- ③ Nanjing University
- ④ Others(University approved by the Foundation)

<p>③</p> <p>Duration of Scholarships</p>	<p>3 years starting from April 2026</p> <p>(1st year Japanese language study ,2-3rd year Master’s course Or (1st year Graduate research student, 2-3rd year Master’s course)</p>
<p>④</p> <p>Scholarship Amount</p>	<p>-Postgraduate student (graduate school) : ¥120,000/month -Auditor of graduate course or during Japanese Language study : ¥100,000/month</p>
<p>⑤</p> <p>School and Examination Fees</p>	<p>(i) The foundation shall cover all required entrance and tuition fees . Cost of study materials, on the other hand, shall be covered by the selected applicant. (ii) The foundation shall bear school examination fees and all other related expenses.</p>
<p>⑥</p> <p>Outfit Allowance</p>	<p>-¥100,000 shall be paid as funds for initial expenses to begin living and studying in Japan. ¥20,000 as part of the above amount shall be handed in the elected applicant’s own country when he/she receives the certificate of the scholarship.</p>
<p>⑦</p> <p>Travelling Expenses</p>	<p>(i) ANA airline tickets (Travelling to and from Japan, respectively to be used at the time of commencing studies and upon completion of our scholarship program.) (ii) A round-trip ANA airline ticket shall also be provided to the selected applicant once during the second year of the scholarship period for home visit purposes to his/her country.</p>

<p>⑧</p> <p>Residence</p>	<p>ANA or university dormitory.</p> <p>If it is inevitable to use a private apartment, the foundation will bear the cost of housing within the limit of ¥50,000 in Tokyo area and ¥40,000 in other districts</p>
<p>⑨</p> <p>Traffic Expenses for Commuting</p>	<p>The foundation shall bear the public traffic expenses for commuting between the residences designated by the foundation and the university.</p>
<p>⑩</p> <p>Others</p>	<p>(i) Counseling</p> <p>The foundation shall provide information and consultation services on matters related to living in Japan and on university examinations.</p> <p>(ii) Traveling in Japan</p> <p>1st year : a trip to Okayama, local area in Japan</p> <p>2nd year : a trip to Kyoto and Nara a ski trip to Hokkaido</p> <p>3rd year : Free travel after the completion of study in Japan</p> <p>An ANA domestic round-trip airline ticket shall be provided for travel to any one place in Japan (with supplementary travel expenses of a maximum of ¥50,000) .</p>
<p>⑪</p> <p>Medical Expenses</p>	<p>We require all the students to take out the mandatory National Health Insurance. The insurance will cover 70% of your medical expenses, meaning that you will need to pay 30%.</p> <p>However, the students must pay the premium expenses of the mandatory National Health Insurance, which is approximately 1000 yen per month.</p>

Qualifications for Application

Anyone who supports the objectives of the foundation to build his/her own country and to promote international friendship, is outstanding in personality and ability, in sound health and is deemed to be in need of financial assistance for educational expenses, and who meets the following qualifications:

(1) **Be a citizen of the People's Republic of CHINA**

(2) **Be a resident of China on Feb 1, 2025**

(3) **Be born after April 2, 2000 (Recommended)**

(4) **Academic Qualifications:**

Must have graduated from a university appointed by our foundation prior to March 31, 2026 and be able to obtain a letter of recommendation from his/her supervising professor.

The applicants also required to have completed a total of 16 years of education at recognized educational facilities.

(5) **Major:**

The field of study selected by the applicant must be the same as his/her major at the undergraduate level. (Preferably, the applicant should have selected the university of his/her choice and the supervising professor under whom he/her wishes to pursue graduate studies.)

The applicant's proposed research theme should be suitable for study at the graduate level in a Japanese university.

(6) **Language ability:**

Must be able to understand graduate level lectures taught in Japanese or English. Selected applicants who have not yet learned Japanese are required to attend a Japanese language course at a language school for 6 months (approximately 500 hours) prior to coming to Japan.

(7) **Others:**

The student must live alone (without his/her family) for the first year in Japan.

<p>⑫</p> <p>Selection Procedures</p>	<p>The initial selection: Based on submitted documents.</p> <p>The second selection</p> <p>(Only applicants selected on the basis of documentary selection)</p> <p>Writing a short thesis, mathematics and a personal interview</p> <p>These shall be held in the applicant's own country.</p> <p>The selection committee shall consist of professors who are currently teaching at Japanese universities. The applicant shall have a choice of Japanese or English for interview purposes.</p>
<p>⑬</p> <p>Application Procedures</p>	<p>Complete the official application form provided by our foundation. The form must be completed in accordance with the "Instructions for Filling in the Application Form".</p> <p>Required documents:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) School records (2) Graduation certificate (or Certificate of studentship) (3) Health certificate <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A health certificate issued by a doctor clearly stating that the applicant is fit for an extended period of study abroad. The certificate should be written on the prescribed form and completed in English (4) Recommendation from supervising professor stating the academic performance, personality and future prospects of the applicant (5) Recommendation from employer at place of employment (Only for applicants currently employed) <p>Note: Submitted documents will not be returned.</p>
<p>⑭</p> <p>Closing Date for Application</p>	<p>Please contact your university's contact for deadline of submission.</p> <p>The application must arrive at the Okazaki Kaheita Scholarship Foundation Secretariat via each designated university. no later than <u>28th of Mar. 2025.</u></p> <p>(send the documents by EMS or DHL.)</p>

<p>⑮</p> <p>Selection Schedule, Location and Notification of Results</p>	<p>(1) The results of the initial selection by mid of Apr, 2025.</p> <p>(2) Second Selection will be held in <u>mid of MAY, 2025 in Shanghai.</u> (More details concerning the time and place of the selection by mid of Apr. 2025.)</p> <p>(3) Results will be informed at the latest by the end of MAY.</p>
<p>⑯</p> <p>Suspension or Cancellation of Scholarship</p>	<p>The scholarship will be suspended or cancelled if the selected applicant cannot continue his/her studies due to illness or other reasons; if his/her study record becomes unsatisfactory; if the supervising professor regards continued study as inappropriate; or if the selected applicant engages in any conduct regarded as dishonorable to the foundation.</p>
